The visitation.

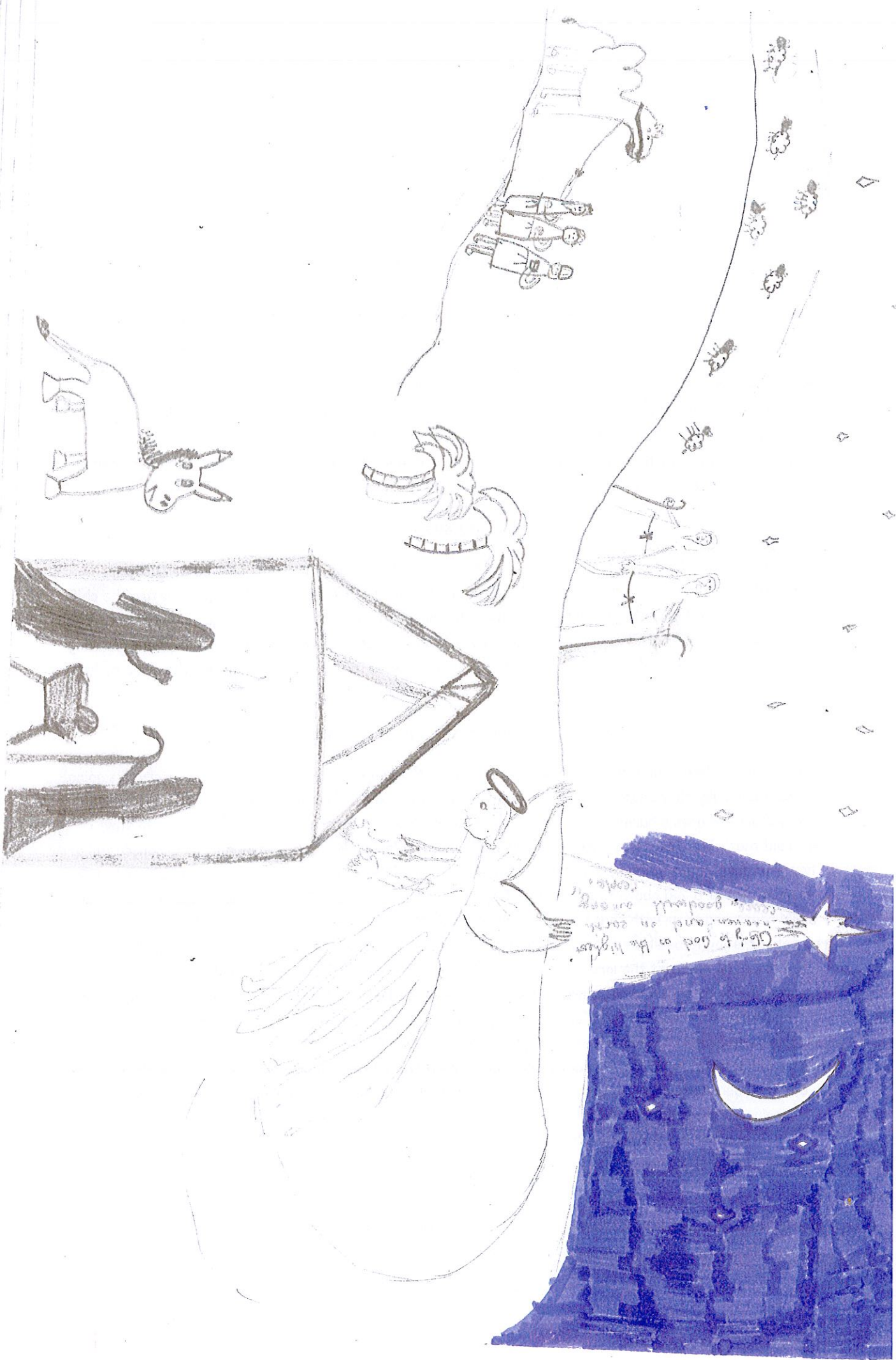
