LITURGY OF WASHING

Water is mentioned a total of 722 times in the Bible, more often than faith, hope, prayer, and worship. In the Bible, it doesn't take long for water to be mentioned. Water is such an essential component of life; it was created on the very first day.

"Go and drink at the spring and wash yourself there!" These are the words of the Virgin Mary to St Bernadette. The ninth apparition, 25th February 1858.

Bishop John: Sign of the Cross and greeting.

RENEWAL OF BAPTISMAL PROMISES

Bishop John:

Dear brothers and sisters, through the Paschal Mystery we have been buried with Christ in Baptism, so that we may walk with him in newness of life.

And so, close to the spring of Massabielle let us renew the promises of Holy Baptism, by which we once renounced Satan and his works and promised to serve God in the holy Catholic Church.

And so I ask you:
Do you renounce Satan?
I do.

And all his works?

I do.

And all his empty promises? I do.

Do you believe in God, the Father almighty, Creator of heaven and earth?

I do.

Do you believe in Jesus Christ, his only Son, our Lord, who was born of the Virgin Mary, suffered death and was buried, rose again from the dead and is seated at the right hand of the Father?

I do.

Do you believe in the Holy Spirit, the holy Catholic Church, the communion of saints, the forgiveness of sins, the resurrection of the body, and life everlasting?

I do.

Bishop John:

And may almighty God, the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, who has given us new birth by water and the Holy Spirit and bestowed on us forgiveness of our sins, keep us by his grace, in Christ Jesus our Lord, for eternal life.

Baptised in water, sealed by the Spirit cleansed by the blood of Christ our king; heirs of salvation, trusting his promise faithfully now God's praises we sing.

Baptised in water, sealed by the Spirit, dead in the tomb with Christ our king; one with his rising, freed and forgiven thankfully now God's praises we sing.



Baptised in water, sealed by the Spirit, marked with the sign of Christ our king; born of one Father, we are his children joyfully now God's praises we sing.

Bishop John:

God our Father, we praise you for the gift of water that sustains life, and above all we praise you for the gift of new life in Jesus Christ. Shower us with your Spirit, and renew our lives with your forgiveness, grace, and love.

To you be given honour and praise through Jesus Christ our Lord in the unity of the Holy Spirit, now and forever.

Bishop John will introduce The Lord's Prayer.
